Arctic Developments Political One bright spot in Arctic development has been political development. Few places in the world can claim to have assumed the level of innovation and ingenuity in political development as the Arctic since the 1980s, driven largely by Indigenous self-determination efforts at the local and subnational levels; and by a proliferation at the regional level of international organizations such as the Arctic Council.
