Douglass understood that the struggle for emancipation and equality demanded forceful, persistent, and unyielding agitation. Douglass escaped from slavery in and rose to become a principal leader and spokesperson for the U. March 3, Three and a half years later, on the evening of October 16, John Brown and 18 "soldiers" seized the U. I could see Harper's Ferry only as a trap of steel, and ourselves in the wrong side of it. Wise also received letters threatening his life, promising that he would be killed as the South "burned down," if Brown were executed.

Another important source of support for the raid was the white mountain population. black men and women pledged to arm and defend themselves against slave catchers, and while there is no evidence that any of them used their weapons, the League was a clear

expression of the aggressive attitude Brown had toward slaveholders and was urging others to adopt.
