The present level of water pollution warrants that steps be

drinking water supply. Overall, global water consumption has  
increased almost tenfold.

These security of these resources is impacted by riparian conflicts. Moreover  
average farm incomes have increased from 80 to percent as a

those achieved under the former rain-fed conditions;  
incremental labour days used per hectare have increased by 50  
to percent.
